



'Jargon Buster' for Examination Entries:

Candidate Number	A unique four-digit number for each candidate. <i>This must be remembered and candidates are required to enter this on each exam paper.</i>
'Cash In'	Usually denoted by 'SA' on the Exam Entry Code. A 'Cash In' turns a set of individual results (such as Units or Controlled Assessments) into an overall award or grade. Candidates must check that they have a 'cash in' code for each subject that they are entered for. No Cash In = No Result.
Exam Boards	AQA, EDEXCEL, OCR or WJEC
GCSE/B	A unit exam entry
GCSE/FC	GCSE Full Course qualification
GCSE/SC	GCSE Short Course qualification
L2	Level 2 qualification equivalent to a GCSE
Tier	Level of entry (e.g. Foundation or Higher)
UCI	Unique Candidate Identifier (<i>candidates do not need to remember this</i>).
ULN	Unique Learner Number (<i>candidates do not need to remember this</i>).
WBQ/1&2	Welsh Baccalaureate entry codes (National/Foundation)
