Smart watches and FitBits should not be brought into school. Examination regulations ban the wearing of smart watches on the grounds of potential malpractice and cheating. However, there are other implications of smart devices which are of concern: distraction, loss/theft, and safeguarding issues. These devices fall outside our insurance policy. Given the reasons outlined above, you must ensure that pupils wear an ordinary watch - **no smart devices**. If pupils are found to be carrying such devices they will be confiscated and secured and we would require a parent/carer to collect them.
