Parent Governor Vacancy

There is one vacancy at this school for a Parent Governor. Nominations are invited for this position from parents and carers of pupils currently registered at the school. Parent Governors are elected by other parents and usually serve for a period of four years. Designated nomination forms are available from the school.

The nomination form must be fully completed; that is you must give the necessary details of proposer, seconder, and obtain the consent of the nominee. If you wish to nominate any parent (or indeed be nominated yourself), you should ensure the nomination form is returned to the Headteacher of the school by **12.00 midday on Wednesday 6th February 2019**. Any nominations received after this deadline cannot be processed.

As a School Governor you will be part of a team of twenty one who spend on average a couple of evenings a month during term time at meetings. These are the Termly Full Governing Body Meeting and Sub-Committee Meetings. If elected, we are sure you will find the work extremely rewarding.

Please think about nominating yourself for this vital work which serves to improve the quality of learning of pupils in the school.
