#### Lost Property

This is a reminder that all items of clothing should have the pupil's name displayed in them. Please understand that there are over 700 pupils in the school. This is not a primary school and we expect all our pupils to be responsible for their own belongings.

If an item of clothing is found in a classroom it is moved to the hanging pegs in that classroom so that when a pupil realises the item is missing they can retrace their steps to find the item. At the end of every half term all property remaining in the classrooms is taken to the social court and displayed for pupils to identify and recover.

Therefore, lost property will be displayed in the social court for pupils to view throughout the day on **Wednesday, 10<sup>th</sup> July** and for Parents / Carers to view between 3.45pm-4.15pm on the same day.
