I would like to take this opportunity to reiterate the guidance given by the Welsh Government. If you have at least one of the Covid-19 symptoms (however mild);

**a new continuous cough,
a high temperature,
loss of or change to sense of smell or taste**

you must **self-isolate** at home for at least **10 days** from when your symptoms started and **arrange** to have a **test**.

The evidence remains clear that the most effective way to protect yourself and others from infection is to follow social distancing rules, avoid touching surfaces and your face, and wash your hands regularly. Please ensure your child has a face covering as they should be worn in all communal areas of the school and on school transport.
